

RESOLUTION 1998-17

SPEED LIMIT ON SECOND STREET  
BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, is a legally elected, qualified and acting body and has jurisdiction of the following described road; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the public health and welfare, and on the basis of a traffic investigation, which bears on the fact that the present speed limit on the following described road is greater than is reasonable or safe under the existing conditions, it is deemed in the public interest that the speed limit on the roadway be reduced as herein set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1560, that the speed limit of the following described roadway be ordered reduced as described:


Thirty (30) miles per hour commencing at a point of beginning 50 feet East of the Northwest Corner of the Southwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 19 South, Range 13 West; thence East along the North line of the Southwest Quarter to the Northeast Corner of the West One-Half of the Southwest Quarter, said point being 1,270 feet, more or less, East of the point of beginning.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that all sign installation shall be made and maintained by Barton County and in accordance with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" as sanctioned by the Kansas Department of Transportation; and


FURTHER, should this Resolution be in conflict with any previous resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners that only the conflicting part of any previous resolutions and not the previous resolution in total be declared void and ineffective.

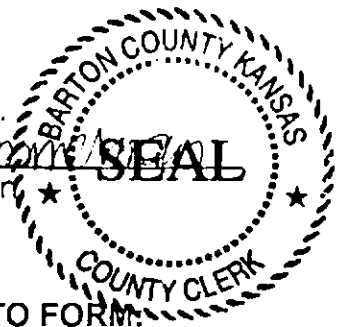


