

**RESOLUTION 2001-12**

**SPEED LIMIT ON NE 30 ROAD IN BARTON COUNTY, KANSAS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, is a legally elected, qualified and acting body and has jurisdiction of the following described roads; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to protect the public health and welfare, and on the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation, it is deemed in the public interest that the speed limit on the roadway be increased as herein set forth.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 8-1559 and 8-1560, that the speed limit of the following described roadway, be ordered increased as described:

1. NE 30 Road from US 281 Highway to NE 40 Avenue – to be increased to 55 miles per hour
2. Intersection of NE 30 Road and NE 10 Avenue – advisory speed to be increased to 45 miles per hour

**FURTHER**, that all sign installation shall be made and maintained by Barton County and in accordance with the "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways" as sanctioned by the Kansas Department of Transportation; and

**FURTHER**, should this Resolution be in conflict with any previous resolutions of the Board of County Commissioners that only the conflicting part of any previous resolutions and not the previous resolution in total be declared void and ineffective.


**FURTHER**, that this Resolution shall be published once in the official County newspaper.

**ADOPTED** this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2001.



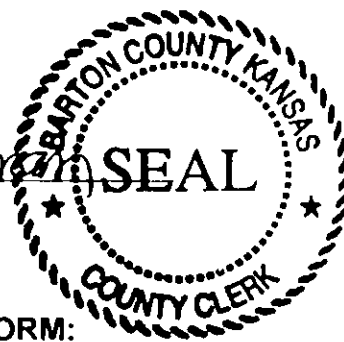


