

**RESOLUTION 2004-12
PLACEMENT OF TRAFFIC SIGNS**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, has jurisdiction to place and maintain traffic control devices upon roadways under their jurisdiction as they may deem necessary; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed in the public interest to control and regulate traffic at the intersection of various Barton County roads within this jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in an effort to assure proper placement, Barton County was assisted by the Kansas Traffic Engineering Assistance Program (TEAP), offered through the Kansas Department of Transportation; and

WHEREAS, through TEAP, a comprehensive study of all intersection control signage was completed in Barton County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, that in accordance with the TEAP Analysis, dated September 2003 and incorporated herein by reference, traffic signage in the unincorporated areas of Barton County shall be regulated as recommended; and


FURTHER, that the regulated signage shall include, at a minimum, stop, yield, stop ahead and cross road signage; and

FURTHER that all sign installation shall be made and maintained by the Board of Barton County Commissioners in accordance with the "Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices" as set forth by the Federal Highway Administration and adopted by the Kansas Department of Transportation; and

RESOLVED that should this Resolution be in conflict with any other resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, that only the conflicting part of the previous resolution, and not the previous resolution in total, shall be declared void and ineffective.

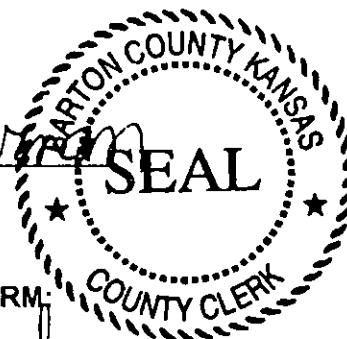


