

RESOLUTION 2008-11

**ESTABLISHING A SPEED LIMIT ON
SOUTH WASHINGTON AND SW 20 ROAD**

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, are empowered to set speed limits on County highways that allow for both the safe operation of all vehicles and convenience for citizens.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Barton County, Kansas, as a legally elected, qualifying and acting body that has jurisdiction of the following described road, it is deemed in the public interest that the speed limit on the said roadway shall hereby be set:

FIRST, that the speed limit of the following described road be, and the appropriate signs erected in accordance with the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), Forty (40) Miles per Hour, at one-half (1/2) mile north of SW 30 Road on South Washington Street around on SW 20 Road to 281 Highway; and


FURTHER, this described speed limit shall become effective after the publication of this Resolution in the official County newspaper and upon the installation of appropriate signage.
