EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I – Road and Bridge Department until position is filled. Operates heavy equipment, hauls materials, removes snow, etc. Must have valid Kansas Class A CDL driver's license.

TEMPORARY LABORERS – Road and Bridge Department until positions are filled. Starts \$10.00 per hour. Work generally during the summer months assisting with road maintenance, related work. Must have valid KS driver's license, Class B CDL or higher (can obtain after hire).

EQUIPMENT OPERATOR I – Landfill until position is filled. Operates and maintains heavy equipment. Assists with Household Hazardous Waste collection and with all other operations at the Landfill. Must have valid Kansas CDL driver's license or obtain within 90 days of hire.

TAX CLERK – Treasurer's Office until position filled. Completes vehicle title transactions, issues license plates, renews registrations, accepts tax payments. Strong computer, math and customer skills required. Most work completed on in-house AS\400 program and Excel.

EQUIPMENT TECHNICIAN \ CLERK – County Clerk \ Information Technology Offices. \$9.00 - \$17.50 hour pay range. Primary responsibility includes set up, testing and maintenance of election equipment. Other duties include assisting with all elect duties; assisting IT staff with order, set-up and maintenance of County computer equipment; input of motor vehicle data and general office duties for the County Clerk. Computer skills required. Must lift and move up to 35 pound voting equipment.

DETENTION OFFICER – Sheriff's Office until positions filled. Works shifts, must have no felony convictions and valid KS driver's license.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELOR – Central Kansas Community Corrections, Gateway to Recovery. Conducts Drug / Alcohol evaluations, individual and group therapy for clients in substance abuse treatment program. Requires good verbal and written communication skills. Current LCAC / AAPS certification required.

ON-CALL WORKER – Barton County \ Juvenile Services. Seeking individuals with ability to respond to local law enforcement centers and juvenile placement facilities. Administers state testing instruments, makes appropriate referrals. Excellent written, oral communications. Conflict resolution skills essential. Must be a minimum of 21 years of age, possess valid Kansas DL, high school diploma or GED, successfully complete JIAS training, pass a criminal background check and pre-employment drug test.

TRANSPORTATION OFFICERS – Barton County \ Juvenile Services program. Using County vehicle, will transport juveniles in custody of Juvenile Services on an as needed basis. Must possess valid Kansas driver's license, pass drug screen and criminal background check.
