## I. OPENING BUSINESS:

Commissioner Schartz called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M.

Commissioner Edmonds moved to approve the agenda with the exception of Item A.

Commissioner Schremmer seconded the motion.

Commissioner Schremmer moved to approve the minutes of the April 25, 2011 Regular Meeting.

Commissioner Kruckenberg seconded the motion.

All voted aye. Motion passed.

## III. NEW BUSINESS:

### A. DISCUSSION: Tagging Vehicles:

-KSA 8-127 provides that every owner of a motor vehicle intended to be operated upon any highway in the state is to be registered within the state of Kansas. At this time, the Commission will ask that the Sheriff and Treasurer join in a discussion on measures that can be taken to correct tagging issues.

### B. REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL: Trash Hauling Service:

-On March 29, 2011, the County Administrator's Office requested proposals for trash hauling services for six County office buildings to include the Courthouse, Sheriff's Office and Detention Facility, Health Department, Barton County Office Building, Road and Bridge and Noxious Weed. The specifications called for a minimum of three pick up dates per week and proof of insurance with a service year beginning June 1, 2011. All local trash haulers got a copy of the proposal.

Richard Boeckman, County Counselor/Administrator, discussed the following returned bids.

The total being spent on trash service now, between Consolidated and Estes, is \$574. Each bid is below that total. Awarding the low bid, Estes Trash at \$360, would realize the County an avoided expenditure of \$214 per month.

Commissioner Schremmer moved to approve the \$360.00 bid from Estes Trash, LLC for trash hauling services for a service year beginning June 2, 2011.

**C. ORDER OF VACATION: Roadways and Alley Rights of Way – Lyndhurst Place Subdivision, Section 9, T18S, R13W, South Homestead Township:**

-The Commissioners request public comments concerning a proposed vacation of roadways and alley rights-of-way in the Lyndhurst Place Subdivision, Section 9, T18S, R13W, South Homestead Township. The description of roadways and alley rights-of-way follows:

- All of Main Street located between the South right-of-way line of NE 100 Road South to a point located 300 feet South of the South right-of-way line of Miller Street.
- All of Main Street South of the South right-of-way line of Gould Street.
- All of Kansas Avenue located between the South right-of-way line of NE 100 Road and the North right-of-way line of Miller Street.
- All of Barton Avenue from the South right-of-way line of NE 100 Road South 300 feet.
- All of Miller Street between the East right-of-way line of Kansas Avenue and the East right-of-way line of Main Street.
- All of the Alley right-of-ways located in Blocks 5,6,8,9,10,11, and 12.

*Easements in said rights-of-way will be retained for drainage and utility purposes.*

At this time, the Commissioners will receive public comment and consider vacating the aforementioned roadways and alley rights-of-way.

Richard Boeckman, County Counselor/Administrator, provided a background on the request. Bj Wooding, Cartographer, reported the area has been mapped as vacated since reappraisal, but no official paperwork is on file. Clark Rusco, County Engineer, discussed the vacating process and read the description.

Commissioner Schremmer moved to adopt the Order of Vacation for Roadways and Alley Rights-of-Way in Lyndhurst Place Subdivision as read by Clark Rusco.  
 Commissioner Kruckenberg seconded the motion.  
 All voted aye. Motion passed.

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## **D. COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE: Request for Approval for Orders of Abatement and Refund of 2010 Taxes:**




Commissioner Edmonds made a motion to adjourn at 9:22 A.M.
