Barton County buildings requiring pest control are the Barton County Courthouse located at 1400 Main Street; the Health Department located at 1300 Kansas; the Barton County office building located at 1806 – 12th; the Road and Bridge Department at 2401 – 7th; the Noxious Weed Department at 2300 – 6th, all in Great Bend, and the sheriff's training annex at 396 NE 30 Road, Great Bend Kansas.

The vendor shall submit a proposal showing its proposed price to provide pest control by completing and submitting the information described below:

Vendors wishing to submit a proposal must submit a sealed proposal, mailed or hand delivered, to the Barton County Operations, 1400 Main Street, Room 107, Great Bend Kansas by 2 p.m., November 17, 2017. Proposals will not be accepted after that time and date. The sealed proposal should have written on its cover "Barton County Pest Control Proposal."

Vendors submitting proposals shall provide the following:

- This form, with the prices completely filled out and totals added.
- Proof of liability insurance in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 (one million dollars).
- Proof that the vendor has worker's compensation coverage as required by Kansas law.
- A specimen contract provided by the vendor that shows all pest control and extermination services the vendor intends to perform.

Any vendor's proposal not including these requirements will not be considered.

The successful vendor will be required to sign a form provided by the County's insurance carrier that the vendor is an independent contractor and not an employee of Barton County.

Barton County reserves the right to accept or reject all proposals and to accept the proposal most in keeping with the needs of the county. Barton County intends to contract with the vendor most closely meeting the needs of the County for a one year period beginning January 1, 2018.
