REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL HILLCREST MEMORIAL PARK FENCE PAINTING PROJECT

Barton County is soliciting proposals to repair and paint or powder coat fences at the Hillcrest Memorial Park. Bulging and cracked support posts are to be repaired before painting or powder coating. At Hillcrest, the fence to be painted is located on the south and west sides. Work to be completed includes removing or cleaning rust from fence surfaces by sand blasting which will require dismantling fence, moving for repairs and painting, and reassembling. If painting, priming all steel fence surfaces, and painting the fences with black epoxy paint. The primer must be as described on specification sheet provided by builder. The paint must be as described on specification sheet provided by vendor.

If powder coating, the vendor must sand blast, remove or clear rust from the fence surfaces, to prime the fences and to powder coat the fences black. Primer and Black paint or powder coating vendor shall provide a specification sheet for material and description of thickness of coating applied.

The County believes the length of the fences to be as follows:

Hillcrest Cemetery, totaling 1,376 feet

South Section East Side 200Ft.
South Section West Side 200Ft.
West Section 976Ft.

However, the bidder is responsible to measure the fences and to bid based on the vendor's measurements.

Work to be done for each project includes furnishing all labor, materials, construction equipment and incidentals necessary to construct the project. The contractor, by submitting a proposal, warrants and agrees that all work will be done in a workmanlike manner consistent with industry standards. Warranty is to be stated on bid document clearly identifying vendors warranty on the project.

Vendors who decide to submit proposals shall provide the following:

On a separate sheet of paper, the cost of the primer and the price of the paint/powder coating.

The bidder shall then state the cost of labor and other incidentals.

The bidder shall then state a total price.

Proof of liability insurance in an amount not less than \$1,000,000.00 (one million dollars).

Identify scope of work and timetable to get work completed.

Barton County would request all work be completed by October 1, 2017.
