Kansas law requires that taxes be collected on alcohol sold. The revenue is used for State, County and local projects for the benefit of our communities. The Barton County Commission will make the final decision on the distribution of County special alcohol funds for projects. Kansas law has specified how these funds may be used. KSA 79-41a04(e) states, in part, ...Moneys in the special alcohol and drug programs fund shall be expended only for the purchase, establishment, maintenance or expansion of services or programs whose principal purpose is alcoholism and drug abuse prevention and education, alcohol and drug detoxification, intervention in alcohol and drug abuse or treatment of persons who are alcoholics or drug abusers or are in danger of becoming alcoholics or drug abusers. 2017 allocation estimated at \$4,350.00.
