Freedom Challenge will teach work ethic and life-skills while enhancing operational procedures and increase production of the quantity and types of products offered.

Prior to releasing back into a Kansas community, participants would receive training in the areas of: setting goals, organizational skills, quality inspections, inventory management, shipping and receiving, blueprint reading, clerical duties, data entry, machine operation, custodial skills, hand tools, power tools, safety and utility maintenance. These topics are presented on-the-job, in-service or in a classroom.


MISSION STATEMENT
