

GOLDEN BELT MEMORIAL PARK VETERANS 'MEMORIAL

- Veteran must have some residential connection to Barton County to be listed.
- Suggested for inclusion are Rank, Name, Branch of Service and any special notes (POW, MIA, KIA, etc).
- Where possible, common title and military branch abbreviations will be used.
- The County must have 540 commitments (per stone) for engraving before the project moves forward.
- Engraving can be cancelled and monies returned at any point before stone is ordered.
- If the project does not move forward, all monies will be returned.
