Amy Miller, Emergency Management Director, told the committee that an important part of Hazardous Materials planning is exercising the plans. She said that today she would be conducting a workshop for the LEPC members that would not just focus on the response to the incident but also consider what LEPC members could do for the residents of Barton County in the recovery phase.

LEPC members participated in a workshop – Barton County LEPC Chemical Danger 2021. The results of the exercise will be reported to the Kansas Division of Emergency Management not only for LEPC participation for a hazardous materials exercise but also to meet program requirements for the Emergency Performance Grant Program (EMPG).

6. Training Opportunities

Chairman Miller asked if any members had any training information to share. Jim Leftwich, South Central Coordinator, reported that the Kansas Division of Emergency Management is tentatively scheduling training in the June-July 2022 timeframe due to COVID-19.

Miller reported that a tentative date of March 8, 2022, has been set for Storm Fury on the Plains but the final decision of whether the event will be in-person or virtual will not be determined until early 2022.
