

# **Spicy Shrimp Stir-Fry with Zucchini Noodles**



#### Ingredients

- 2 lb. zucchini noodles
- 1/2 c. low-sodium soy sauce
- 2 tbsp. oyster sauce
- 2 tbsp. sherry or dry white wine
- 1 tbsp. sugar
- 1/4 tsp. red pepper flakes
- 3 tbsp. peanut or vegetable oil
- 1 bunch scallions, whites thinly sliced, greens cut into 2-inch pieces
- 1 1/2 lb. large shrimp, peeled and deveined
- Kosher salt and black pepper, to taste
- 8 oz. baby bell peppers, thinly sliced into rings
- 1 small jalapeño pepper, thinly sliced
- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1 tbsp. minced fresh ginger


